Meet Garden Suites Resident: Dorothy Duchscher

Born March 25, 1935, Dorothy was the only child of Bessie and Tony Steinbach, a police officer, and has spent most of her life in Fargo. She was a popular student and enthusiastic cheerleader at Shanley High School, where she never let her studies get in the way of socializing.



After she graduated from Shanley in 1953 (a year behind her homecoming date, Roger Maris), Dorothy went to Interstate Business College and worked as a secretary for Berrell Motor and Pioneer Mutual. While at Berrell she met a curly-haired parts runner and ex-Marine, Gus Duchscher, and the two were married in 1957 at St. Mary's Cathedral in Fargo. As Gus launched his career with the North Dakota Air National Guard, Dorothy had three boys: Kevin, a Star Tribune editor; Kyle, a retired Eden Prairie police detective who now manages the department's evidence room; and Paul, a Catholic priest and pastor in Valley City, N.D.

For years Dorothy worked as a sales clerk at Penney's, and as a dental receptionist and secretary for a vocation's office. After Gus retired in 1989, the couple enjoyed their retirement years traveling around the country and seeing family and friends. When Gus died in 2004, Dorothy became a receptionist for the Diocese of Fargo and worked there until 2018. She has three granddaughters — Jackie, Jennie and Claire — grandson Charlie and great-grandson Bennett, and daughter-in-law Beth all in the Twin Cities.
